Therefore, before Dr. Krejci can accurately treat female patients, our office requires pre-consultation labwork and a referral from a general dermatologist. Dr. Krejci's primary focus is surgical hair transplantation. She is considered a second opinion to a primary alopecia diagnosis. Sometimes surgery is a viable option for women but not always.
